Since our founding in 1892 in Sydney, Australia, Open Air Campaigners has endeavored to go OUT to this great and needy group of unreached men and women, boys and girls. Folks are reached in parks, fairs, factories, housing projects, at the waterfront, schools, colleges and universities.

Get Equipped

The Open Air Campaigners are presenting our exciting Evangelism Training Academy. This one- week seminar is designed to provide training in all phases of conducting open-air evangelistic meetings. All students will be tutored according to their level of experience. Those who attend this seminar will be equipped to go back to their home church or field of ministry in order to conduct fruitful, open-air outreaches.

Target Audience

This seminar is intended for all Christian workers, lay people and students interested in learning principles and techniques of effective open-air evangelism. Adults and teens are welcomed, and you need not have any prior experience in evangelism.



You will get the chance to learn and practice your open-air preaching skills before testing them out in public.

Objectives

At the conclusion of this seminar, participants will be able to:

- 1. Present the gospel of Christ in a direct, positive and challenging manner.
- 2. Prepare evangelistic Bible stories for children and adults with illustrations drawn on a sketch board.
- 3. Discern proper techniques, including location and timing for conducting outdoor meetings.
- 4. Communicate the Gospel one-on-one with adults and children.
- 5. Sense a personal fulfillment of Ephesians 4:12, so that you might “equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ.”

Date and Location

The training will be held Monday, May 31 thru Saturday, June 5, at Washington Bible College in Lanham, Maryland. WBC is located just outside the Washington beltway and is also convenient to the Baltimore area.



The ETA’s limited class size allows for plenty of individual instruction and mentoring with our experienced evangelists.

Fees

The fee of \$325.00 per person includes cost of instruction, all training, materials, travel to and from field meetings, all lunches, and a room at the college for the entire week of training. For commuting students not requiring overnight accommodations, the seminar fee is \$200.00.

Payment in full, or a \$30 minimum enrollment fee must accompany the registration form. Any balance due may be paid upon arrival at the seminar.
